## **Internship at Kunsthaus Hamburg**

The Kunsthaus Hamburg is continuously looking for dedicated and motivated interns who are interested in contemporary art. The two to three-month internship provides insights into the various fields of an internationally operating art institution.

The Kunsthaus Hamburg is a centre for contemporary art. It acts as a participative exhibition venue, a place of artistic production and a platform for the discussion and reflection of cultural policy. Centrally located in the former market hall, the institution presents up to six varying solo and group exhibitions of visual art and related disciplines every year. In collaboration with both young, upcoming and established artists, an experimental programme is created specifically for the exhibition hall. In the spirit of the founding idea, the Kunsthaus Hamburg creates visibility for artists and cultural actors based in the city. It sees itself as an open platform, fostering interconnection on the global level. The focus on the local scene is expanded to include international positions. As a dynamic place with fluid structures, the institution collaboratively promotes diversity and offers space for socially relevant discourses.

The internship offers a comprehensive insight into the diverse fields of activity of a locally and internationally operating art institution and includes tasks in the areas of exhibition and event management, press and public relations, customer service and art education as well as general office work. Depending on your interests, it is possible to focus on different fields.

The Kunsthaus Hamburg welcomes applications by dedicated, reliable and solution-orientated persons with an independent way of working, who are keen to be part of a small team. We particularly welcome students from the fourth semester onwards, who are willing to take on tasks on their own initiative and familiarise themselves with the relevant subject matters. Good knowledge of German and English, MS Office and other common computer and web applications are required. The duration of the internship should be at least two months and is agreed on a full-time basis.
